
Church of Peace

One: We are learning to recognize this ghost asking about love,

Left Side: calling us to tend and nourish each other

Right Side: showing us the way to new life, is new solidarities

One: You'd think, by now we would get used to Jesus in our midst,

Left Side: welcoming us to the worship that is love in action

Right Side: showing us the way to transformation is mutual caring and love.

All: Let us worship God, because we know in our bones, everywhere we turn, it is the Lord!

One: Please join me in our Invocation:

Is it you, Jesus? Are you really here? Is the message you gave us really true? Did the story turn out like you said? Can we trust it is you in the distance when the night is long and our nets empty? Will there be more if we share? Can we find you when we eat together? Do we love you when we feed each other? Jesus, let us follow you always. Amen.


